NEW BOOK CLUB | COOK THE BOOK!





The book series titled Spy x Family is a Japanese <u>manga</u> series written and illustrated by Tatsuya Endo. The story follows a spy who has to "build a family" to execute a mission, not realizing that his adopted daughter is a telepath, and the woman he agrees to marry is a skilled assassin. By March 2024, Spy × Family had over 35 million copies in circulation, making it one of the best-selling manga series of all time. The series received critical acclaim for its storytelling, comedy, characters, action scenes, and artwork.


New Magazine Alert!
