Get out your child's favorite game and make up new rules together.

It's Bean Counter Day. Set out a pile of beans and count them with vour child.

## **Stories**

Look through an old family photo album and take turns telling stories about the pictures.

## **Rhymes**

It's Exercise Day. Ask your child to name as many words as she can think of that rhyme with "run."

## Songs

It's Hanging Out Day. Make up a sona with your child about kicking back and relaxing.
